


Creating Venue Maps – Best Practices


Map Activation and Alignment

Preparation

Ensure individual floor plans are activated before integration.

Alignment

Align the floor plans precisely to maintain consistency across the venue map.




Seamless Navigation with Access Points

Placement

Situate access points near connector pins to streamline transitions between maps.

Experience

Optimize the user experience by enabling easy navigation between different levels.



QR Code Positioning

Place QR codes approximately 3 meters from connector pins for optimal scanning without interference.



Drift Dial Indicator


Enable this feature in Map Settings to show users their mapping accuracy, enhancing user confidence in navigation.

Connector Pins at Transitions

Install connector pins at key entry and exit points like elevators, stairs, bridges, and escalators to guide visitors through map transitions smoothly.



Creating Connections


Pin Types

Create connector pins at entry/exit points for elevators, escalators, stairs, and bridges.



Groups

Maintain associations by grouping connectors for features like elevators, ensuring a cohesive experience.



Pairs

For connectors with defined start and end points, such as a bridge or an escalator, create a pair to establish the connection between the top and bottom / entry exit.



Previewing Map Levels

Visitors will be able to preview different levels of the venue map to plan their route before navigation.
